City of Tulsa gets only \$400 million	City of Tulsa gets \$553 million
\$254 million earmarked for AA bailout	No earmark for AA bailout
County can veto how City of Tulsa wants to spend remaining \$146 million	City of Tulsa has full control over spending \$553 million
Hastily thrown together list of projects designed for short-term political gain; no strategic planning	Carefully considered, strategic projects based on city's comprehensive plan and capital improvements plan
New county-controlled trust to interfere with City of Tulsa-owned airport facilities	City retains full control over City of Tulsa-owned airport facilities
Almost \$100 million wasted on interest and bond fees	Pay as you go: No money wasted on interest and bond fees
